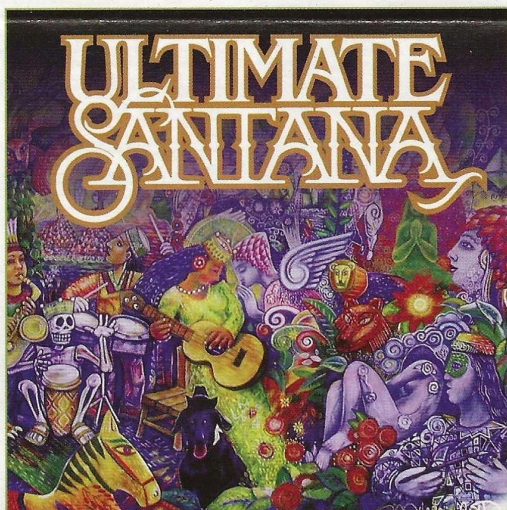

Two artistic visions are found on *Ultimate Santana*, the first anthology to include touchstone tracks from the band's earliest hit making years on Columbia Records, along with the groundbreaking collaborations that highlight the Arista years. The self-titled debut album, *Ultimate Santana*, includes the first Top 10 single, "Evil Ways." From the second album, 1970's *Abraxas*, Tito Puente's "Oye Como Va" and Fleetwood Mac's "Black Magic Woman," plus a Santana original classic "Samba Pa Ti." The early run of Top 40 hits was extended with "Everybody's Everything" and "No One To Depend On," from 1971's aptly titled *Santana III*.

The inevitable reconquest of the singles charts is also celebrated on *Ultimate Santana*, which reprises "Smooth" (co-written by and featuring Rob Thomas of Matchbox Twenty), "Maria Maria" (featuring Product G&B), and "Corazon Espinado" (featuring Maná), all from *Supernatural*; "The Game of Love" (featuring Michelle Branch) and "Why Don't You and I" (featuring Chad Kroeger), both from *Shaman*; as well as other tracks (including an alternate version of "The Game of Love" with Tina Turner, and the album's first single "Into The Night" with Chad Kroeger, both previously unreleased).

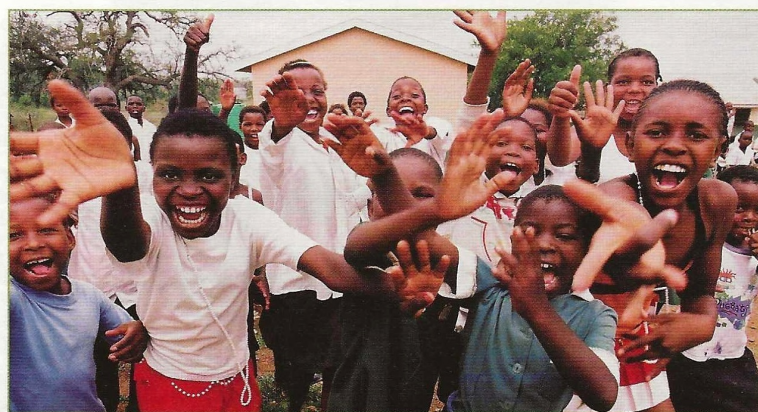

Brownstone Foundation, Milagro

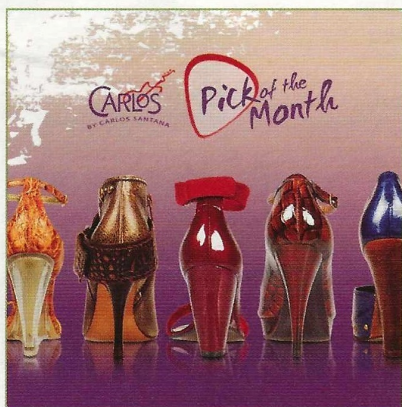


Our Milagro Board granted
\$142,000 to our latest group of
grantees. Included in this group
are Artists for a New South Africa,
supporting children at Simelela, a
rape crisis center and Ingwavuma,
an orphan care cooperative of a
few hundred families raising AIDS
orphans. (\$25,000)

Another new grantee is the Marin
City Health and Wellness Cen-
ter, located across the Golden
Gate Bridge from San Francisco,
California. This clinic is the first
Marin City medical health center
in more than 30 years in a com-
munity where many residents,
particularly seniors and children,

will donate \$30,000 to support the
Health center.

The Autlan Medical Center
(Sanctuary of Light) in Autlan,
Jalisco, Mexico (Carlos' birthplace)
is celebrating its first anniversary.
Built with a \$1,000,000 pledge from
Deborah and Carlos Santana, this
medical clinic is the first in the area
to serve all residents, regardless
of the ability to pay. Now serving
hundreds of families, Santuario de
la Luz will receive \$20,000 from
Milagro to continue its good work.

SALVADOR SANTANA BAND

Salvador Santana and the SSB have just completed their first full-length album, set for official release in February of 2008. In the interim, the band has issued a pre-release that features 10 of the tracks, many of which will be featured on the official February release. Salvador has been co-writing with Andy Vargas and Asdru Sierra of Ozomatli, and is co-producing most of the project with producer, mixer and former Cypress Hill and House Of Pain collaborator Jason Roberts. Salvador has also collaborated with producers Oliver Leiber (Paula Abdul, The Corrs) and DJ NU-Mark (Jurassic 5) to create two amazing tracks that are pumping and ready for radio. "These songs make everybody get up and dance, they just get the party going." – Salvador Santana.

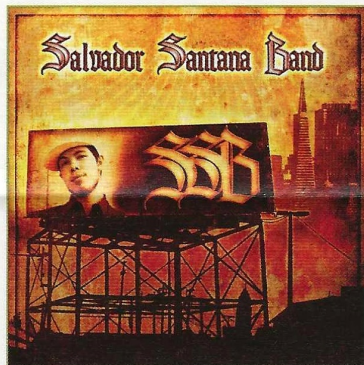
Salvador is currently on a 3-month tour with the B-Side Players and Cipes and The People, sponsored by Myspace en Español.
