

Carlos to attend Peace Conference and Concert June 30th-July 1st, 2007- Carlos to attend Peace Conference and Concert in Bochum Germany entitled "Challange Future" - "Herausforderung Zukunft". At the conference, Carlos will join several other prominent figures such as: Archbishop Desmond Tutu, President Mikhail Gorbachev, Peter Maffay and Jane Goodall, (just to name a few) and will discuss seven topics, all chosen by Archbishop Tutu.
